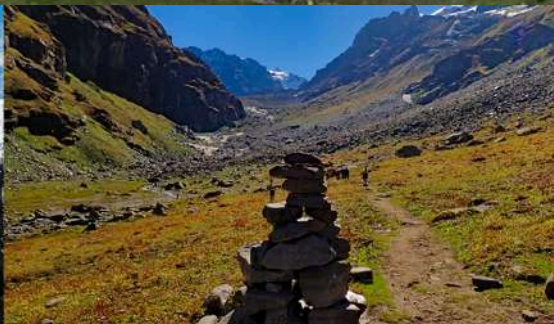

DESCRIPTION

The Hampta Pass Trek is a breathtaking journey through the diverse landscapes of Himachal Pradesh, connecting the lush green valleys of Kullu to the stark, barren beauty of Lahaul. This moderate-level trek, usually spanning 4–5 days, offers an incredible variety of scenery—from dense pine forests and expansive meadows to glacial valleys and dramatic mountain passes. The trail climbs to an altitude of about 14,000 feet at Hampta Pass, offering panoramic views of snow-capped peaks and sweeping vistas. Along the way, trekkers cross rivers, camp beside serene lakes like Chandratal, and experience the changing colors of nature at every turn. Perfect for both beginners and seasoned trekkers, the Hampta Pass Trek is an unforgettable Himalayan adventure.

Wildflowers bloom along the trails in summer, adding bursts of color to the alpine landscape. The ever-changing terrain keeps the trek exciting, with each day offering a new backdrop. Rich in natural beauty and cultural charm, the Hampta Pass Trek is a must-do for nature lovers and thrill-seekers alike. The trek also provides a unique glimpse into the lifestyle of remote mountain villages.

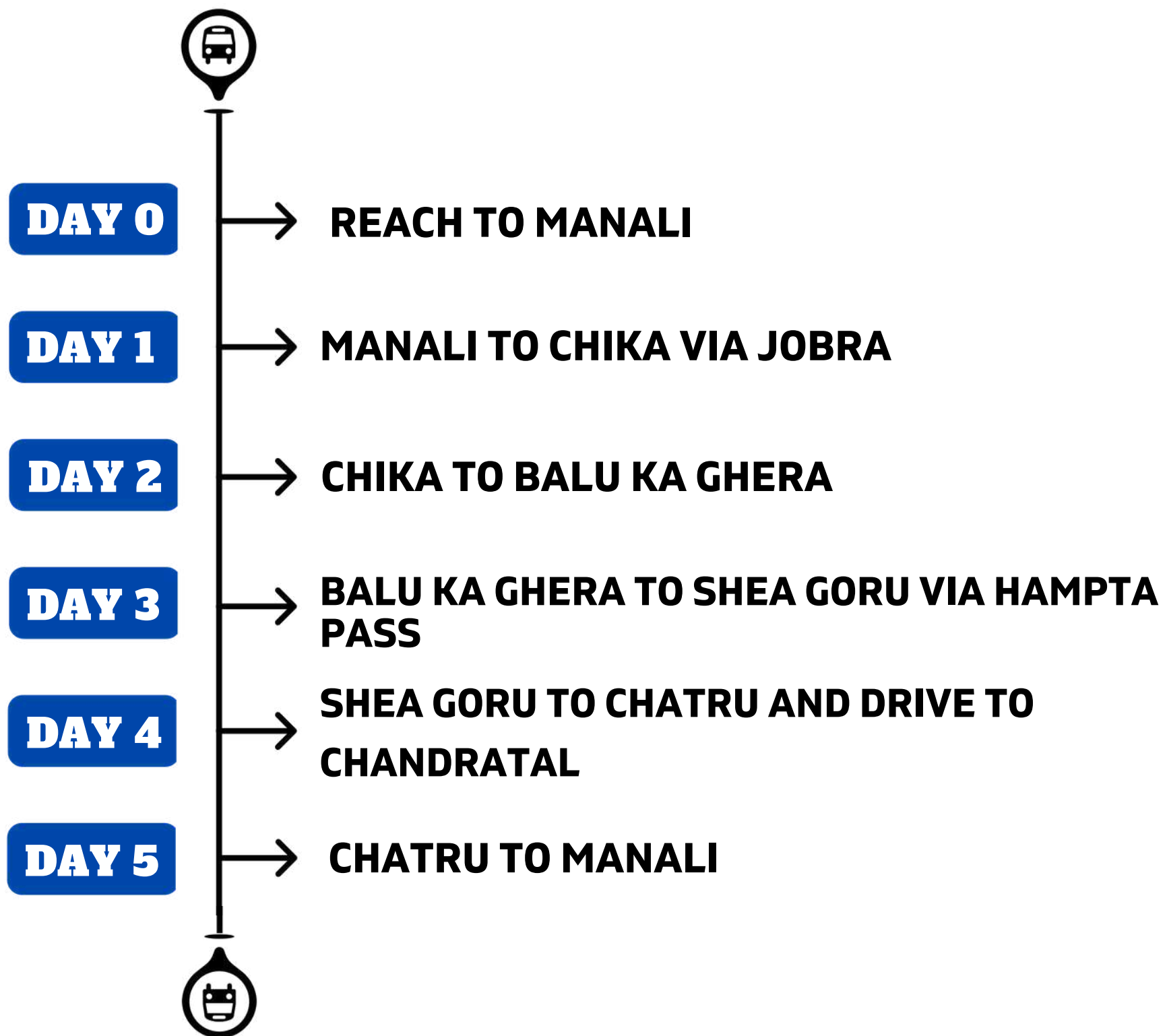

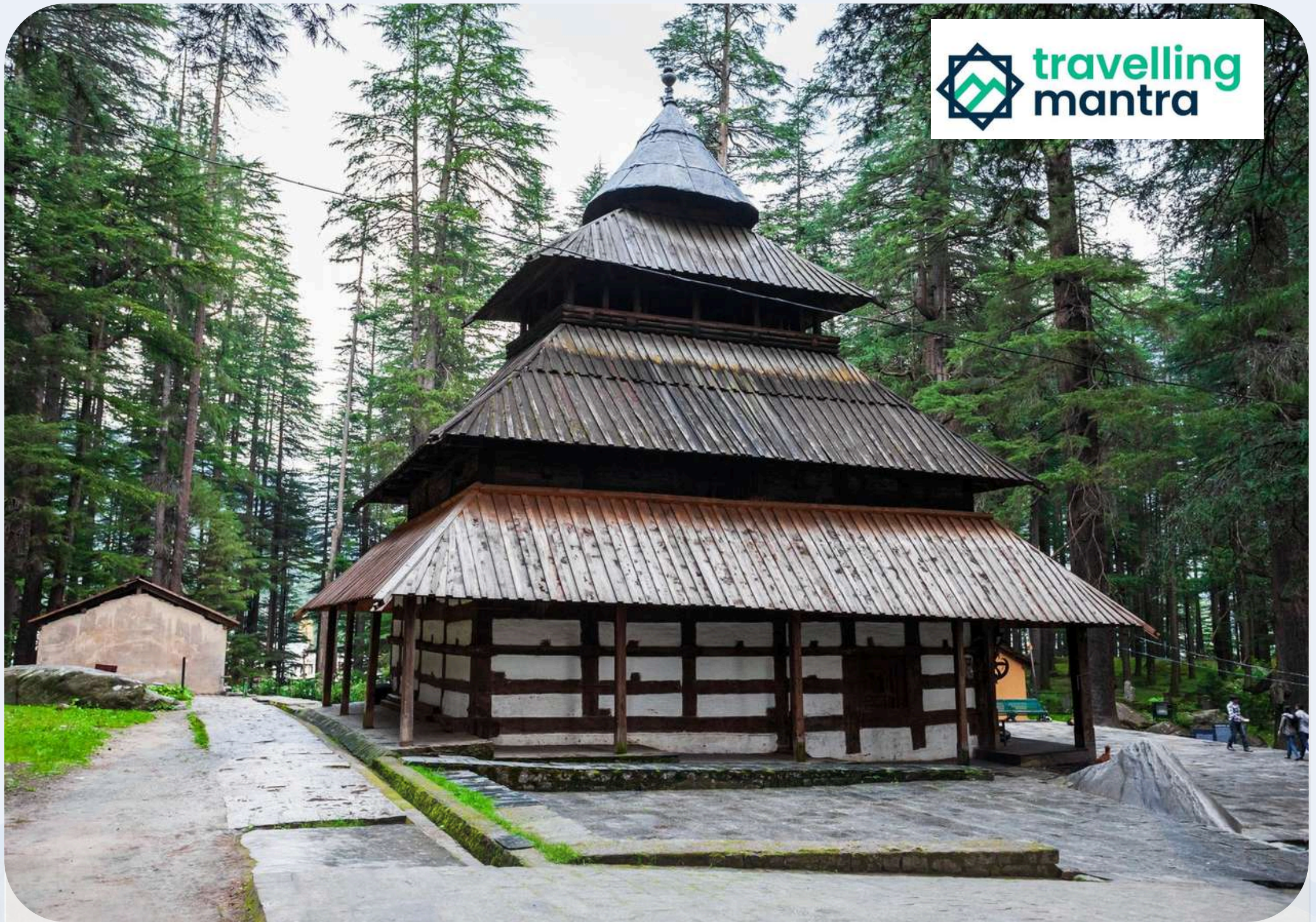

DAY 1

MANALI TO CHIKA VIA JOBRA

Drive - 16 Km | Time - 2/3 Hr | Meal - Dinner

- Begin your adventure with a scenic drive from Manali to Jobra. This
- 16 km drive takes approximately an hour and offers stunning views of the lush green valleys and snow-capped peaks. Upon reaching Jobra, the trekking journey commences. The trek from
- Jobra to Chika is relatively short, covering 2 km and taking around 1 hour.
- This gentle trek leads you through picturesque meadows and forests, eventually arriving at the Chika campsite situated at an altitude of 10,100 ft. Spend the night camping under the stars, surrounded by the serene beauty of nature.



DAY 2

CHIKA TO BALU KA GHERA

Trek - 9 Km | Time - 5/6 Hr | Meal - Bf & Dinner

- After breakfast, set off on a 9 km trek from Chika to Balu Ka Ghera, a journey that takes about 5 to 6 hours.
- The trail meanders through beautiful alpine meadows and streams, providing stunning views of the Dhauladhar range.
As you gain altitude, the landscape becomes more rugged and the air crisper. Balu Ka Ghera, situated at 12,400 ft, is a vast expanse of sand and rocks, resembling a riverbed. It serves as an ideal camping spot, offering breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains.

DAY 3

BALU KA GHERA TO SHEA GORU VIA HAMPTA PASS

Trek - 7 Km | Time - 8/9 Hr | Meal - Bf & Dinner

- This day is the highlight of the trek, as you cross the Hampta Pass.
- The trek from Balu Ka Ghera to Shea Goru covers 7 km and takes around 8 to 9 hours.
- The ascent to Hampta Pass at 14,100 ft is challenging but rewarding, with panoramic views of the towering peaks and glaciers. After crossing the pass, descend towards Shea Goru. The descent is steep and requires careful navigation.
- Shea Goru, nestled in a valley, is a tranquil campsite with a river flowing beside it. Rest here and soak in the natural beauty after a long day of trekking



DAY 4

SHEA GORU TO CHATRU AND DRIVE TO CHANDRATAL

Trek - 7 Km | Time - 4/5 Hr | Meal - Bf & Dinner

- Begin the day with a 7 km trek from Shea Goru to Chatru, which takes about 4 to 5 hours.
- The trail descends further, passing through rocky terrains and scenic landscapes. Upon reaching Chatru, you will be greeted by the stunning views of the Chandra Valley. From Chatru, embark on a 50 km drive to
- the mesmerizing Chandratal Lake, which takes around 3 hours to reach and 2 hours to return. Chandratal, also known as the Noon Lake, is a high-altitude lake located at 14,100 ft. Spend some time exploring the lake's pristine beauty before heading
- back to Chatru for the night.



DAY 5

CHATRU TO MANALI

Drive - 65 Km | Time - 5/6 Hr | Meal - Bf

On the final day, drive from Chatru back to Manali, covering a distance of 65 km.

The drive takes approximately 3 to 4 hours, passing through the scenic landscapes of the Spiti Valley and the Rohtang Pass. Reflect on the incredible journey as you make your way back to the bustling town of Manali.

Upon arrival in Manali, the trek concludes with memories of breathtaking views, challenging trails, and the serene beauty of the Himalayas.

Note: You can visit Chandratal if road and weather conditions permit us. Drive from Chatru to Chandratal and back to the campsite, either on day 4 or day 5 (depending on road and weather conditions)

INCLUSIONS

- Transportation: Manali to Manali

- Accomodation: Hotel, Homestay, Camping
- Camping charges: Camping and forest permit fees for Indian Nationals

- Sleeping bags, mattresses, Utensils
- Safety equipment: First aid medical kit, oxygen cylinder, stretchers, ope
- Mountaineering qualified and experienced Trek leader, Guides, Cook and Support staff
