

## **VALLEY OF FLOWERS TREK WITH HEMKUND SAHIB**



Valley of Flowers "Foolon ki Ghati" is one of those beautiful trekking expeditions that can be enjoyed during the monsoon season. It is flawlessly nestled in the West Himalayan region of Uttarakhand and lies at a lofty height of 3600 m above sea level. With an opportunity to spot the very rare blue Primula, the Valley Of Flowers trek is one of the best-known treks in the world. In 1980, Indian government created the Valley of Flowers National Park, and later in 2002, it was recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage Site

## **DETAIL TREK ITINERARY**

**DAY 1 - : DRIVE RISHIKESH TO JOSHIMATH (260 KM / 10 HRS)**

**ALTITUDE: 6,150 FT**

10 hours drive from Rishikesh to Joshimath. The pick-up location is Rishikesh bus stand, pick up time will be in Rishikesh at 6:00 AM. We will be passing by the 4 of the Panchprayag or the five holy confluence of Ganga—Devaprayag, Rudraprayag, Karnaprayag, and Nandaprayag. reach joshimath in the evening. overnight stay in joshimath.

**DAY 2 - DRIVE JOSHIMATH TO GOVINDGHAT - PULNA AND TREK 9KM TO GHANGARIA [ 5 - 6 HRS ] ALTITUDE - 9800 FT**

Early Morning breakfast, later drive Joshimath to Govindghat-pulna the distance is 25km. En route, you can spot the final Vishnuprayag. We will start off on the drive in the morning after breakfast and reach Govindghat by 8 am and then 4 km drive to Pulna which is the starting point. It will be a 9 km uphill trek route along the river, Pushpawati. The entire trail will be crowded most of the time. Many snack shops selling the beverage, many more things. reach Ghangaria before evening. overnight stay in shared guest house.

**DAY 3 - GHANGARIA TO VALLEY OF FLOWERS AND BACK TO GHANGARIA**

**ALTITUDE- 11500 FT. || TREK- 8 KM BOTH WAY**

Wake up with the stunning fluorescent views of sun rays on the mountain peaks, get refreshed to trudge again. After breakfast start your trek to Valley of flowers. The journey to Valley of Flowers is a distance of 4 km. The valley is 6-7 km long and ends with a glacier, the distance travelled in the valley depends on how the trekkers want to explore the valley. Right, when you start from Ghangaria in 30 minutes forest check post arrives. The check post might not be an attraction but right before check post, there is a gushing waterfall called Laxman waterfall. Another 20 minutes into the greenery and next furious attraction comes. At this point, the Pushpavati river flows furiously below a wooden bridge. It is quite a common yet a unique and mesmerizing capture. The trail is steep and stone paved like the previous day. You can find many bridges and landslide areas when you enter the valley. The valley is thousand times stupendous than you might have imagined. It truly makes the Himalayan peaks lively and cherishing. Blue Poppy, Snake Foil, White Leaf Hog Foot, Himalayan Rose, Meadow Geranium, Dog Flower, Hooked Stick Seed are the native flowers. These astounding colorful blossoms end after 5 km stretch at a glacier. If the weather is clear the mighty Himalayan peaks of Nilgiri Parvat, Bhyundar Khal, Rattaban, Gauri Parvat etc. in the background. Today's journey will conclude with your coming back to Ghangaria before nightfall. overnight stay in Ghangaria.

**DAY 4 - GHANGARIA TO HEMKUND SAHIB AND BACK TO GHANGARIA**  
**DISTANCE: 12 KM | DURATION: 8 HOURS | ALTITUDE : 14,100 FT.**

Get ready early in the morning to start trekking (6 Km one way) for "HEMKUND SAHIB". One of the most revered of all Sikh Shrines, The Hemkund Sahib, the World's Highest Gurdwara, is situated at an altitude of 4,329 meters. There will be porters and mules if you wish to offload your load. The trail today will be similar to previous days stone paved and continuous ascend. There will be shops on the way where you can energize yourself.

Watch out for the rare flower Brahmakamal and blue poppy that will be spotted beside pathways. The Gurdwara is placed magically beside the mirror like glacial lake Hemkund.

During clear skies, one can witness the flawless reflections of the adjoining Saptrishi peaks. The lake is fed by melting glaciers of Hathi Parvat and Saptrishi peaks. Religious Laxman temple is also found near the lake. In the afternoon trek down 6km to reach Ghangaria for an overnight stay. The evening is free for rest & relaxation.

## **DAY 5 - GHANGARIA TO PULNA - GOVINDGHAT AND DRIVE TO JOSHIMATH.**

**TREK: 9 KM (5 HRS) | DRIVE - 25KM**

After your breakfast in the morning we descend to Govindghat and then drive to Joshimath. From this place Badrinath is 25 km away and take 1 hrs to reach. You can visit Badrinath at extranal cost, only if road and weather condition permits us.

Note : Govindghat to Badrinath is landslide prone area in monsoon time so if our leaders find that your safety is in risk due to weather condition/landslide or road blockage we shall skip Badrinath altogether and drive to Joshimath directly.

On arrival, check into hotel. Overnight stay in Joshimath.

## **DAY 6 - JOSHIMATH TO RISHIKESH DRIVE - 270 KM**

After morning teadepart to Rishikesh. You will reach Rishikesh between 6.00 pm and 7.00 pm, You can book further travel any time after 9:00 pm,

The Valley of Flowers Trek ends here, take back a mosaic of unbelievable memories with you.

**NOTE - Kindly take an extra buffer day and it will be depends completely on the weather conditions on the trek and travel time.**

- **2 Night Joshimath and 3 nights ghangaria.**

- **First aid medical kits .**
- **Mountaineering qualified & professional trek Leader, guide and Support staff.**
- **Transport from Rishikesh to Rishikesh by Deziro, bolero and tempo traveller ( Depends on the number of group size). ( AC cost is not included in transportation).**

## Exclusions

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- **Any extra meals and stay arrangements apart from the ones mentioned under inclusions as per the itinerary.**
- **Travel Insurance, items of a personal nature like portorage, tips, laundry etc.**
- **Any entry fees, extra expenses for optional activities or tickets, unless quoted in Inclusions.**
- **Cost of snow-chained or 4\*4 Vehicle if needed due to heavy snowfall/ road blocks.**

- Only Rucksack is allowed No suitcases/trolleys will be allowed.
- Full Payment of the Trek cost must be made before the trek begins. Pending Payments may eventually lead to the Cancellation of the trek.
- No refunds shall be made towards any inclusion(s) not availed by the trekker.
- All extras are to be paid directly to the hotels/the service providers.
- Trekkers must take care of their luggage & belongings. The management shall not be responsible for any damage or any missing items along the trek.
- The time of Departure is stated & fixed. All travelers must update their status with the coordinator(s), & report at the pickup point 30 mins prior to the scheduled departure. Anyone missing the bus shall not be eligible for any refunds. We shall call you twice before the schedule departure.

- sometimes while travelling to base camp and back to rishikesh their are chances of route diverting due to closer of main road. in that case if group is choosing external long distance routes then increasing of travel distance will be chargeable extra and pay directly to driver total increased cost of travel.
